Gov. Ivey Announces Revive Plus Grant Initiative: \$200 Million for Alabama Small Businesses, Not for Profits & Faith-based Organizations

Clients & Friends -

Yesterday, Governor Kay Ivey announced the Revive Plus initiative for Alabama small businesses (50 or fewer employees), Alabama not for profits and Alabama faith-based organizations. Two hundred million of the State's CARES Act funding is being dedicated to providing a second wave of grants up to \$20,000 to reimburse qualifying entities for business interruption expenses.

The State of Alabama will offer these cash grants on a first-come, first-served basis. This grant is *in addition to* any State of Alabama Coronavirus Relief Fund grant previously received, including the Revive Alabama small business, not for profit, faith-based, and healthcare provider grants. The application period will be open from noon on Monday, November 23, 2020 through noon on Friday, December 4, 2020.
